Charter Member Evelyn Hatfield (seated) is surrounded by Pi Chapter supporters at her 100th birthday celebration on June 6 at the Evansville Country Club. Friends and family enjoyed the celebration as accolades from Charles DeMaio, Director of ISU Alumni Association and John Newton, Retired Director of ISU Alumni Association who presently works part-time for the ISU Foundation at Indiana University, recounted Evelyn's many achievements.

Evelyn Church Hatfield graduated from Garfield High School in Terre Haute, Indiana, in 1930 and tied for the highest grades. She graduated from Indiana State Teachers College (now ISU) in 1934 and received the Hines Medal for having received the highest grades, the only award given at Commencement. She was a member of Pi Omega Pi and Kappa Delta Pi. Evelyn received her MED in 1942 from Harvard University. She was a business teacher starting in Ridgway, Illinois, in 1937 and was there for two years. From there she taught business at Central High School in Evansville, Indiana, until she retired. About twenty years ago, the Central High School Class of 1943 that Evelyn sponsored established a \$1000 scholarship in her name that is given annually.
